





John Uboldi presented Larry Waggner and Nick O'Jeda for our program. These men teach at the Healdsburg High School and are responsible for the Migrant Education Program. This is a federally funded program which teaches the children of migrant workers (many of whom know no english) and encourages them to continue their education. This is done not only with language help, but by getting them jobs in the community which enable them to better themselves and to give them the ambition to get a high school diploma and even to go on to college. Twenty of these students, age 13 and up, now hold jobs in town.
