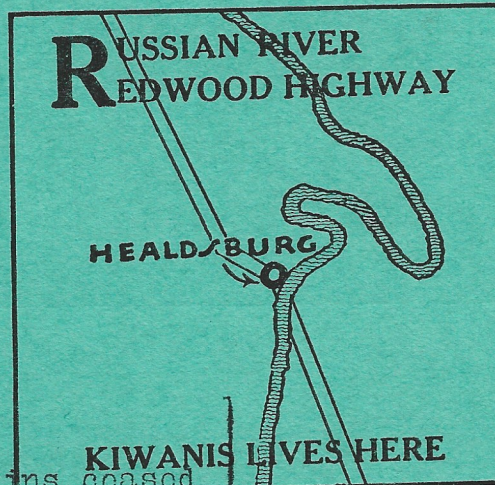

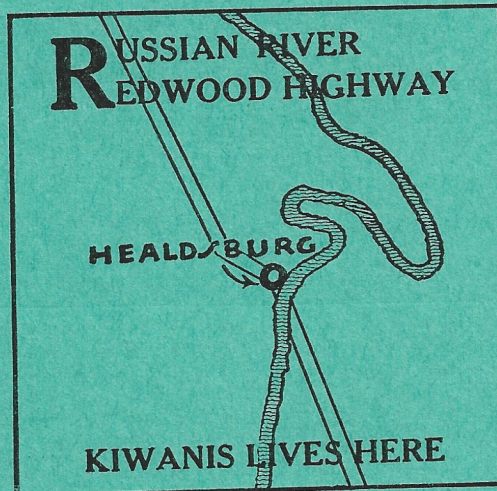

To our club - all of us - "The best bunch of boys who ever put powder in a safe."



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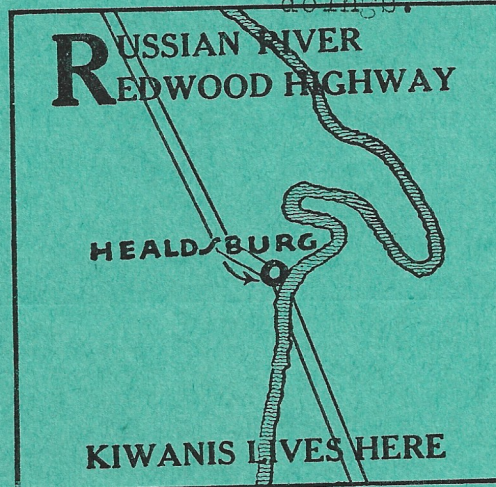
