HEALDSBURG KIWANIS HAS SPONSORED 7 CLUBS IN IT'S HISTORY; 1925 SANTA ROSA. 1926 EUREKA, 1948 UKIAH, 1952 GEYSERVILLE, 1962 CLEARLAKE, 1971 SEBASTOPOL AND 1992 WINDSOR.

1925 THE KIWANIS CLUB OF SACRAMENTO SPONSORED A CLUB FOR "KEY BOYS" IN THE LOCAL HIGH SCHOOL. THIS FIRST KEY CLUB WILL EVENTUALLY GROW INTO THE WORLDS LARGEST SERVICE CLUB FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS, BUT FOR THE NEXT DECADE THE KEY CLUB IDEA WILL SPREAD SLOWLY, AT FIRST IN CALIFORNIA AND THEN OTHER STATES.
