There were sixty charter members in the newly formed Healdsburg Kiwanis Club on November 3rd, 1923 and Joe Miller was installed as it's first President. The first activity undertaken was to transport the Lytton Home Band to Sacramento to participate in a state band contest for youth groups.

Our first money raising project was in 1924 when we sponsored a Variety Show in the old Liberty Theater. The money raised went to the "Healdsburg Community Chest" to help needy families. Frank Corrick was master of ceremonies.

LAST WEEK'S MEETING

Ben Collins introduced Nick Esposti, our 4th District Supervisor, who gave a very enlightening program on the Counties hospital and it's problems. The County is required to give hospital care to the indigent, medicare and medicaid patients, without regard to their ability to pay for the service and because of the new competing hospital now receives only 53 cents for every dollar spent. Several approaches are being explored to correct the situation.

Mr. Esposti pointed out what great service was available here because of the low ratio of patients to doctors and the modern equipment owned.
