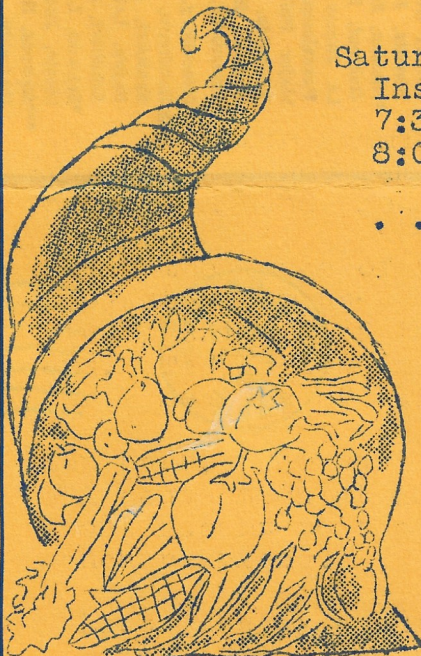
Ken Barr, who was the delegate to the national FFA convention at Kansas City, will also give a short report to the club. Be sure and bring a rancher friend.
