Healdsburg Key Club would like to send as many members as possible to the Santa Clara convention to familiarize them with Key Club goals. To do this the Club will use money budgeted for a delegate to the International convention to send additional members to the District convention. Money for members convention expenses would come 1/3 from the Key Club, 1/3 from the member and 1/3 from the Kiwanis Club to a maximum of the \$1500.00 budgeted for the Key Club by Kiwanis.
